Course Description: The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has granted the first ever clearance for “Periodontal Regeneration – true regeneration of the attachment apparatus (new cementum, new periodontal ligament, and new alveolar bone) on a previously diseased root surface when used specifically in the LANAP® protocol.” LAPIP [Laser Assisted Peri-implantitis] and LAR clinical cases will be shown. LAPIP is a laser treatment option to treat ailing/failing implants. Other procedures to be discussed are gingival depigmentation, gingival contouring, hemangioma treatment and more.

She worked for Lares Research selling air abrasion and laser technologies [both Argon (curing) and Nd:YAG (soft tissue) lasers] – the PerioLase. She produced the highest revenues among a 24 member national sales team in 1998 and was awarded the Outside Sales Representative of the Year award.

In 2004, Jean started her own company in order to offer a focused Menu of Services to Dental Professionals. She assembled tools and technologies geared toward providing a higher level of patient care as well as to provide the dental practice a greater occurrence in patient acceptance of diagnosed and recommended treatment. She re-joined Millennium Dental Technologies in 2005 and represents Middle/East TN, KY, NC, WV, VA, DC, DE and MD. In 2012 Jean was awarded Top Sales Performer for the Company. In 2014, Jean received special recognition for submitting the largest contract in the history of Millennium Dental Technologies, after bringing the United States Army on board. In 2015, Jean secured the contract for implementation of LANAP and the PerioLase MVP-7 into the United States Navy Periodontal Residency Program. Jean enjoys training and teaching staff members, speaking at Study Clubs, RDH Associations and for her doctors at private events.
